WHAT WE DO

Located in Phoenix, the Governor's Office of Strategic Planning and Budgeting (OSPB) advises the Executive on financial and strategic decision-making for Arizona. A highly visible agency at the center of State government, OSPB is responsible for recommending and implementing a \$65 billion budget. OSPB also works on projects to improve the State. Key investments in the FY 2024 Enacted Budget include:

- ➤ \$300.0 million to ensure necessary funding to support K-12 public school districts and repeal of the Results-Based Funding Program, which diverted vital resources away from the most vulnerable schools.
- > \$200.0 million for homelessness shelter and services, transitional housing for those who served in the military, mobile home relocation, low-income and affordable housing services, and assistance for emergency and rapid rehousing.
- > \$189.2 million for long-term water infrastructure investments to secure Arizona's water future.
- > \$89.0 million to address a funding shortfall to widen I-10 between Arizona's two largest cities, Phoenix and Tucson.
- > \$23.6 million to ensure rural Arizona can meet the match requirement to draw down approximately \$1.0 billion in Federal funding.
- > \$5.0 million to expand the income eligibility limit for the KidsCare Medicaid to serve approximately an additional 13,700 kids.

With over 120 State agencies and boards, OSPB analysts interface with agency management to identify problems and provide solutions to the Governor.

By recommending data driven solutions to real world problems and by presenting solutions to the Governor and the Governor's executive team, OSPB analysts develop the analytic and communication skills necessary to thrive in today's workforce.

OSPB analysts also serve as consultants to the Governor's Office on strategic initiatives, providing analytics and research support to help guide State strategy.

Analysts will gain increasing levels of responsibility and can advance their careers in the office. OSPB is also a training ground for leadership roles in State government and business, and former analysts are now Agency Directors, Chief Financial Officers, and Consultants.
